## **Week Five (Jan. 29-Feb2)**

Bible Theme: Jesus Shows His Power  
Shape: Triangle Color: White/Blue  
Opposites: Front/Back  
Craft: Triangle fish, making snow  
Show and Tell: Something Blue

A few reminders:

January brings two exciting new activities for the children. The first is Show and Tell which will be on Thursdays of each week. Please limit your show and tell to something that will fit in their bag and ideally have their name on it (written on a piece of tape works great!).
